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From $X\#(1) = -X(1)$, we find that $-c2\mu2\sin\mu + c2\mu\cos\mu = -c2\mu\cos\mu - c2\sin\mu$. Hence μ is a solution of the equation $-\mu2\sin\mu + \mu\cos\mu = -\mu\cos\mu - \sin\mu \Rightarrow 2\mu\cos\mu = (\mu2 - 1)\sin\mu$ Note that $\mu = \pm 1$ s not a solution and $\cos\mu = 0$ is not a possibility, since this would imply $\sin\mu = 0$ and the twoequations have no common solutions.

Thus the solution of the partial differential equation is $u(x,y)=f(y+ \cos x)$. To verify the solution, we use the chain rule and get $ux = -\sin x f_0 (y+ \cos x)$ and $uy = f_0 (y+\cos x)$. Thus $ux + \sin x uy = 0$, as desired.
